COMMUNITY BASED TRAINING INFORMATION

The Community Based Training Site Program is a WIN-WIN program for employers as well as consumers enrolled with the Achievement Center - Easter Seals.

Employers agree to train and utilize consumers in their work place for the amount of hours and days agreed upon.

During the training period, the Achievement Center will cover the consumer's salary and workers compensation/liability. We will monitor the consumer's progress weekly, discuss any concerns as needed, and provide on site supervision/training when stipulated.

Within the training period, the employer or the consumer may request to be re-assigned if they feel that the position is not a "good fit".



The employer has the option, but is not obligated, to hire the consumer during or at the end of the



training period. The Achievement Center will then provide another consumer to fill the training slot.
