• Students are prepared to achieve the level of health/science knowledge, patient care skills, and abilities that are needed and required to provide basic care to patients/residents in long term care facilities. The class will prepare students to pass the (NNAAP) two-part state exam and be placed on the Alabama Nurse Aide Registry. The class is open to all counties and assistance with tuition can be received from the Alabama Department of Rehabilitation Services and the Alabama Career Center (WIOA), and East Alabama Health.

In FY 2021-2022, 22 students completed the class; 8 students didn't complete the class; 4 students started the class at the end of the FY and will complete next FY; 19 students took the NNAAP Examination; 15 students passed the NNAAP Examination; 4 students failed the NNAAP Examination.
